About Personal Conferencing for AIX

Personal Conferencing for Advanced Interactive Executive (AIX) (hereafter called *Personal Conferencing*) is a remote conference tool that provides multi-media real-time conferencing capability. It requires only a single normal telephone line.

Before you begin to use Personal Conferencing:

1. Be sure that a minimum of 32 megabytes (MB) of accessible memory and 12MB of free disk storage are available in the system.

Notes:

1. To install Personal Conferencing, these filesets need to have been installed.

Installing Personal Conferencing

To install Personal Conferencing, use the System Management Interface Tool (SMIT).

- 1 Turn on your computer and start AIX.
- 2 Put the *Personal Conferencing for AIX CD* into the CD-ROM drive.
- 3 Login as *root*.
- 4 Type **smitty install_latest**; then press **Enter**.
- 5 Type **/dev/cd0** after *INPUT device / directory for software*; then press **Enter**.
- 6 Type **pmcs** after *SOFTWARE to install*; then press **Enter**.
- 7 Follow the instructions that appear on the screen; then be sure *Ok* appears.

Note: After installation, read the **README** file that was installed with Personal Conferencing and placed in the **/usr/lpp/pmcs** directory. It includes more details about Personal Conferencing.

Starting Personal Conferencing

At the AIX prompt of *aixterm*, type **pmcs**; then press **Enter** to start Personal Conferencing.

Notes:

1. The first time you start Personal Conferencing, you will be requested to enter *your name, phone number*, and several other items.
2. Personal Conferencing should be executed in the AIXwindows environment.

Quitting Personal Conferencing

To quit Personal Conferencing, go to *Conferencing Service* screen, and select **File** from the menu; then select **Exit**.

Customizing Personal Conferencing

To change or remove the Personal Conferencing setting for your user name, phone number, and other items, follow these steps:

- 1 At the AIX prompt of *aixterm*, type **pmcscfg**; then push **Enter**.
- 2 Follow the instructions that appear on the screen.

Notes:

1. This program should be executed in the AIXwindows environment.

Solving Problems

If you have a problem while using Personal Conferencing, follow these steps:

- 1 If you receive any error messages while using Personal Conferencing, check the *Error Messages Lists* located in the **/usr/lpp/pmcs/Messages** file.
- 2 If you have a problem and no error message is displayed, check the *Notices* in the **/usr/lpp/pmcs/README** file.
- 3 If you do not resolve the problem with steps 1 and 2, have the system serviced. See "Getting Service" on page 6.

Getting Service

During the warranty period, you can get toll-free technical support to answer any questions about your new IBM software.

When you call for service, have the following information ready:

- Description of the problem
- Hardware and software configuration information for your system

If possible, be at your computer. Your technical support representative might want to walk you through the problem during the call.
