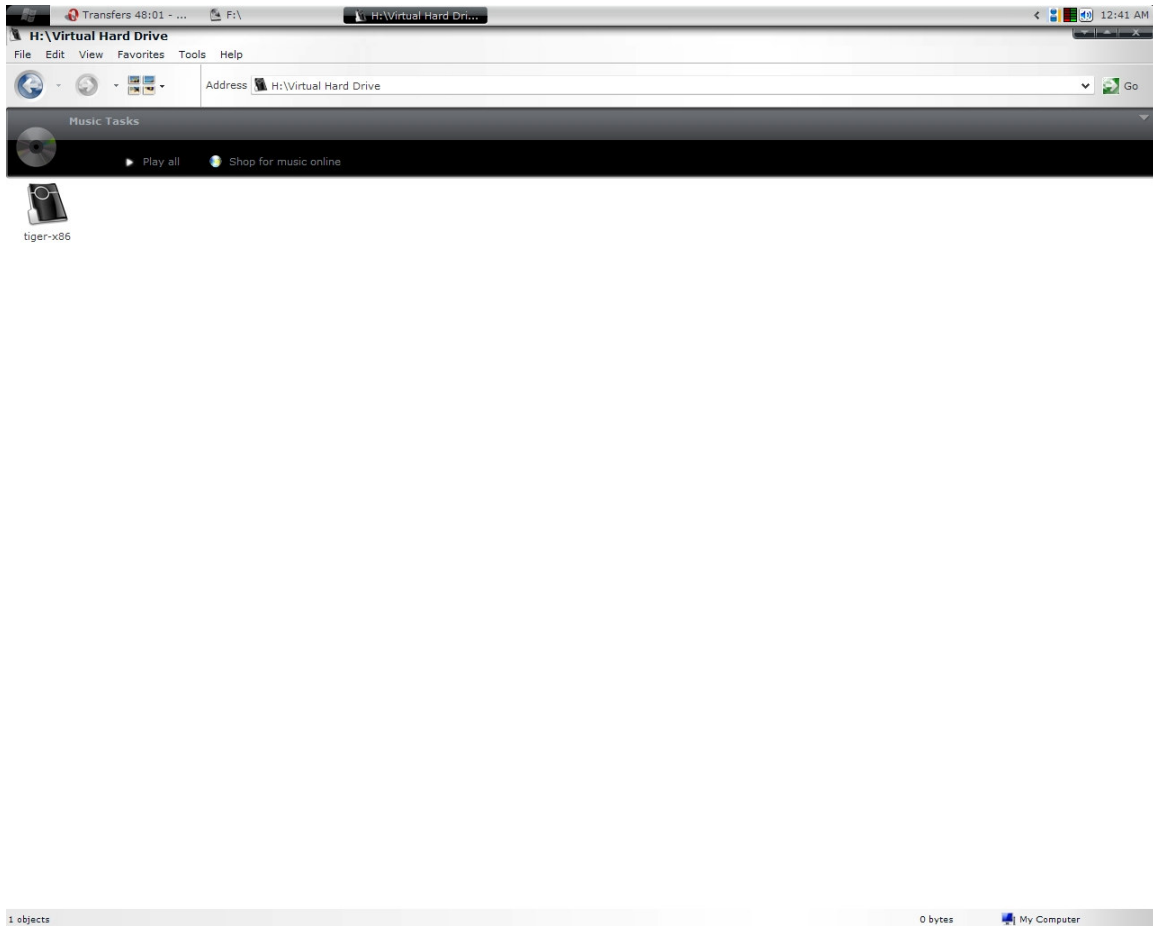


# Launching Mac OS X Tiger x86 in VMware

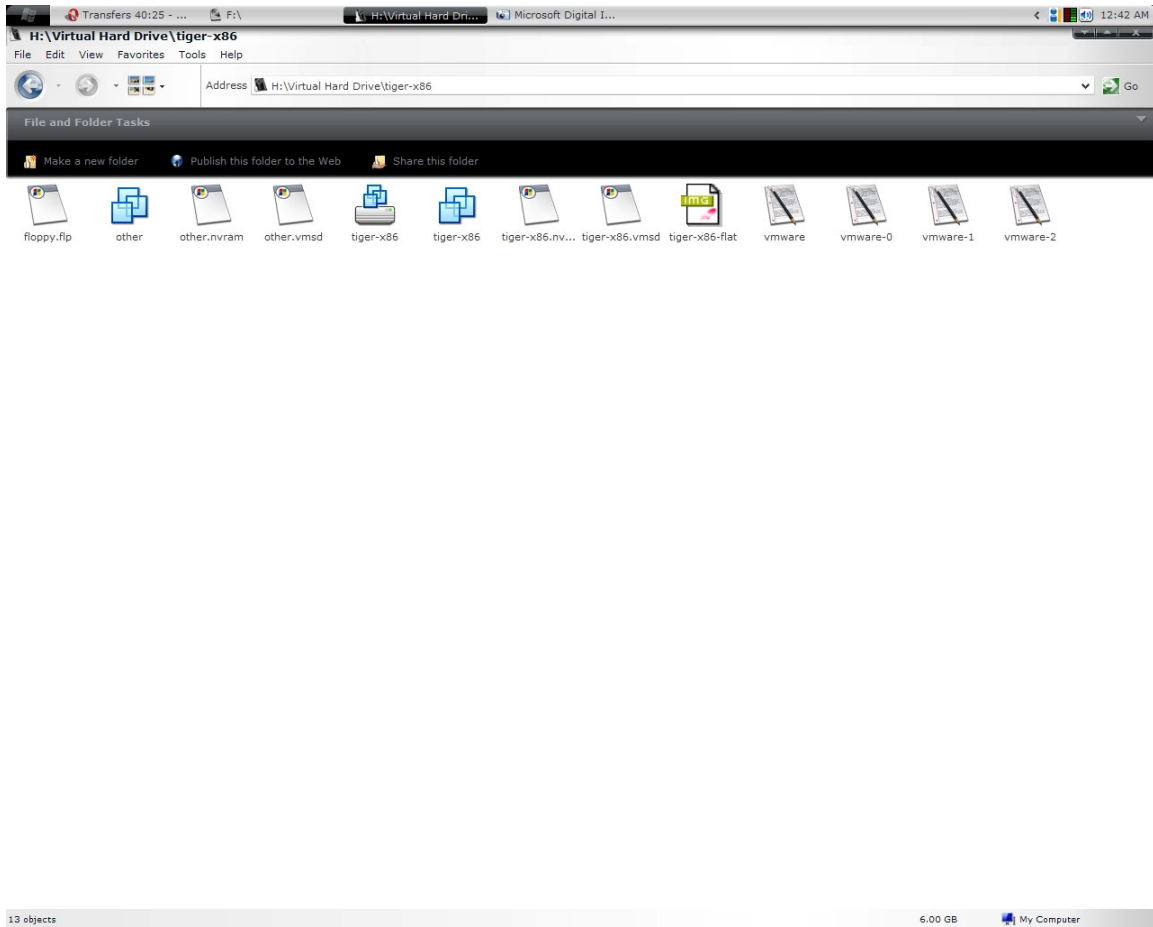

First, install VMware Workstation 5.

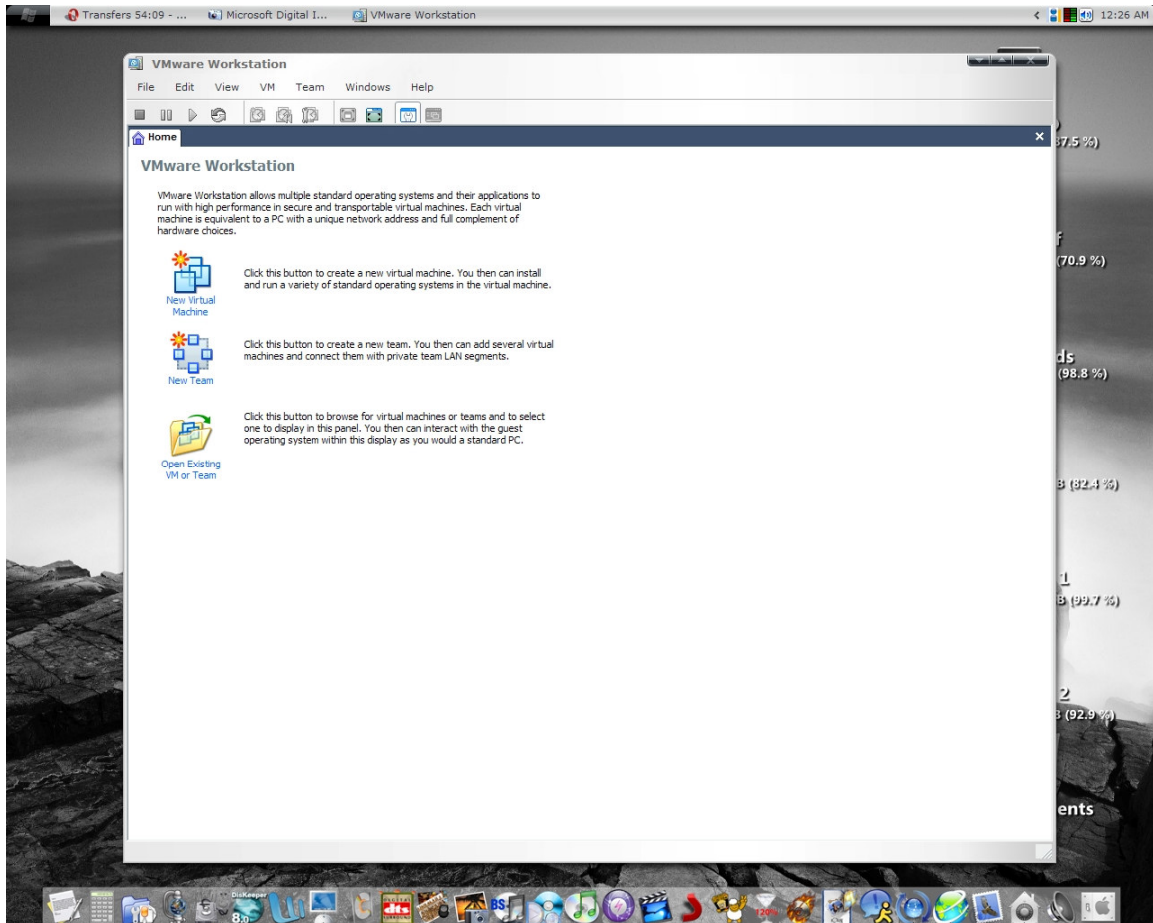
Second, make sure your Tiger-x86 for VMware folder is on a drive or partition with 10gb or more.



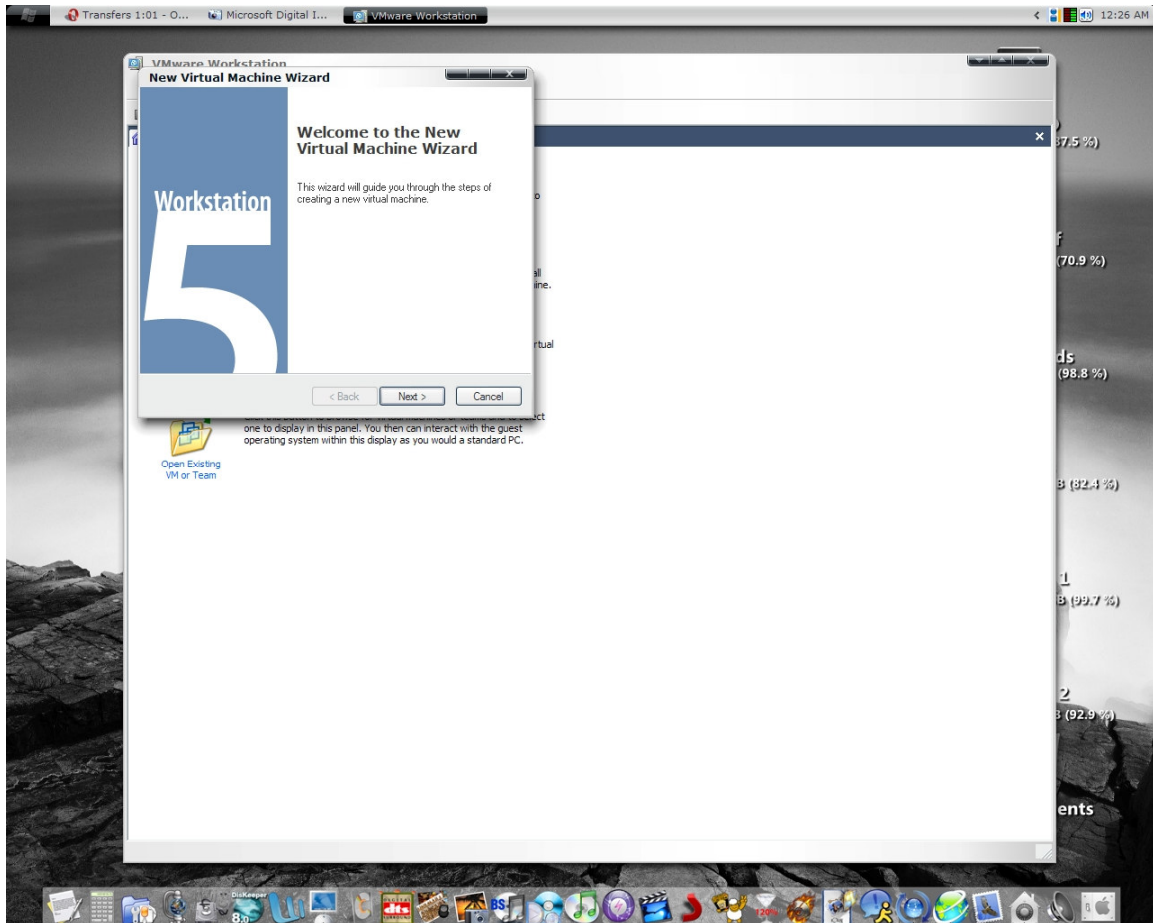

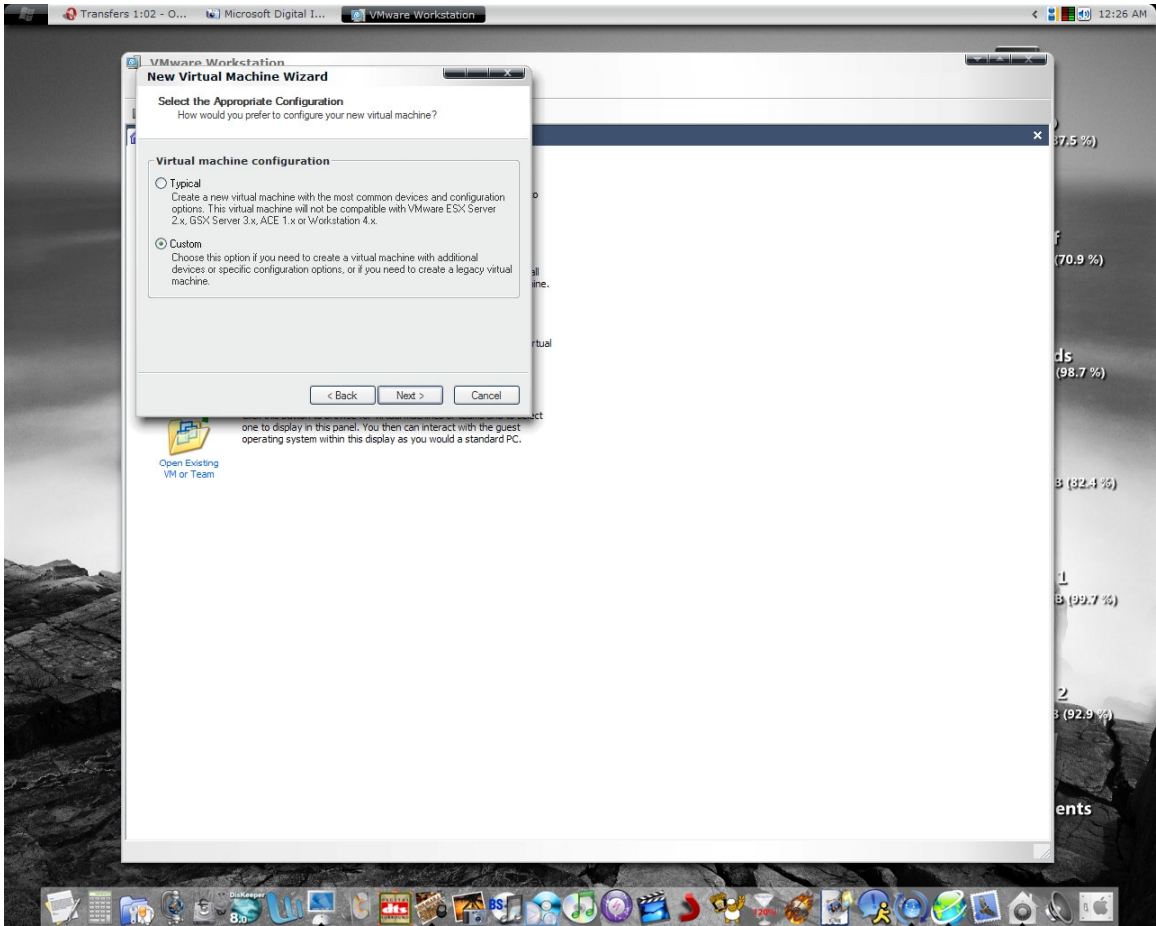


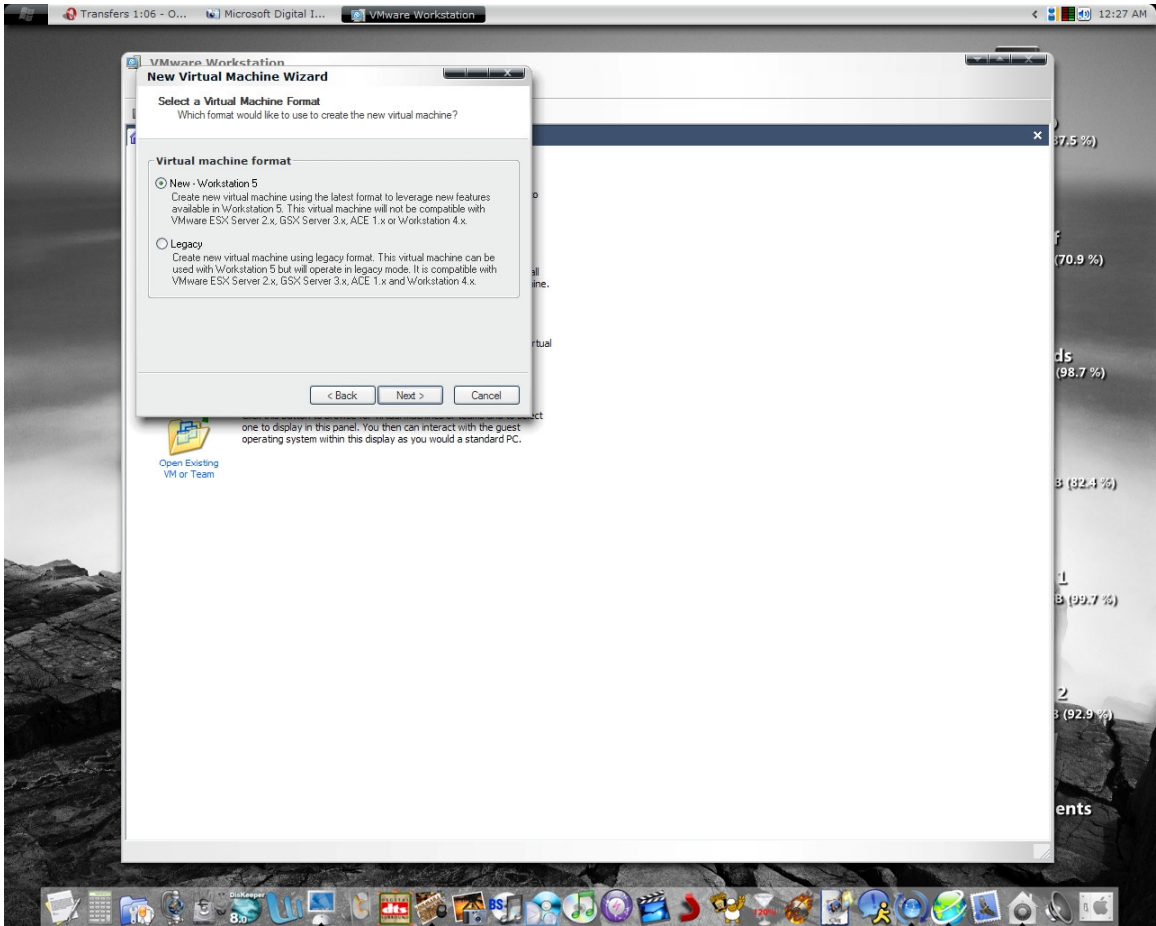
## Now, launch VMware Workstation 5.

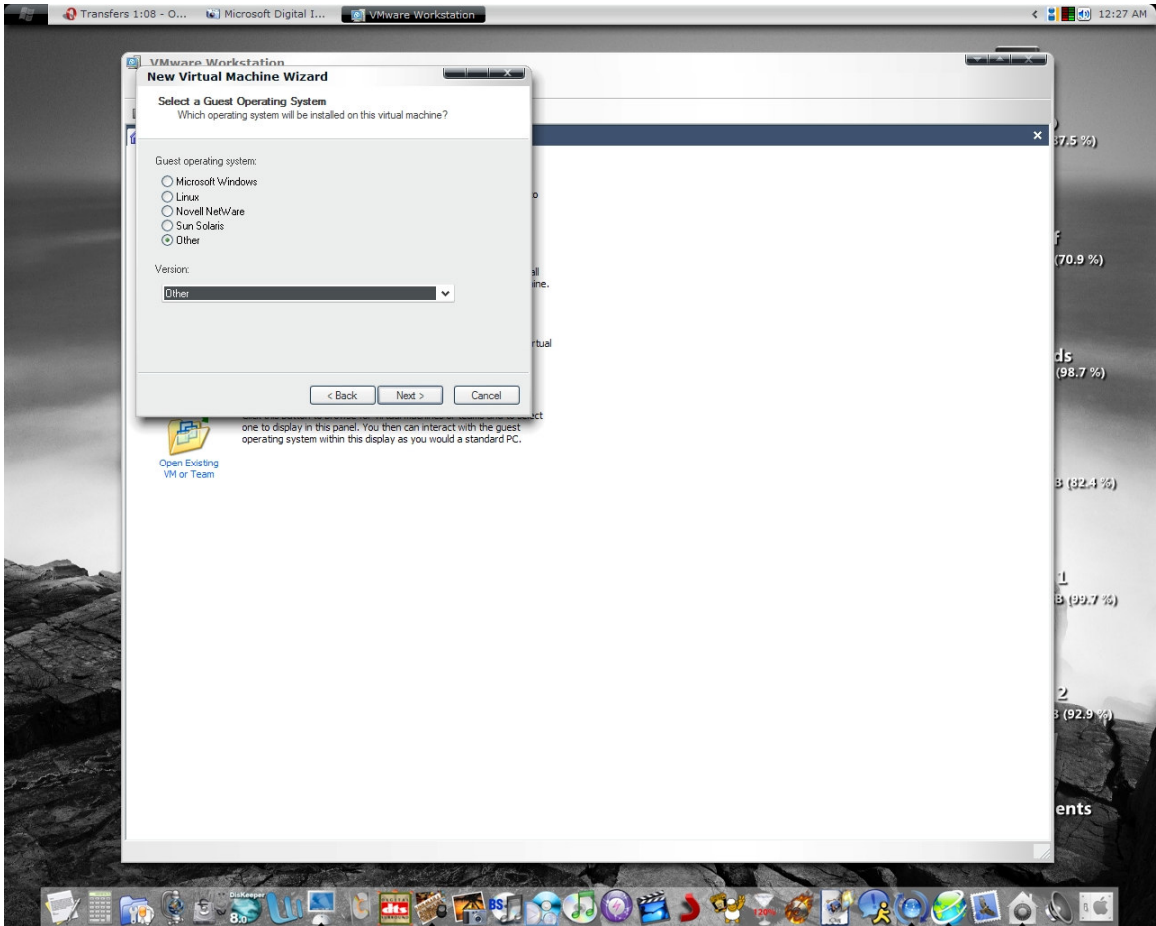


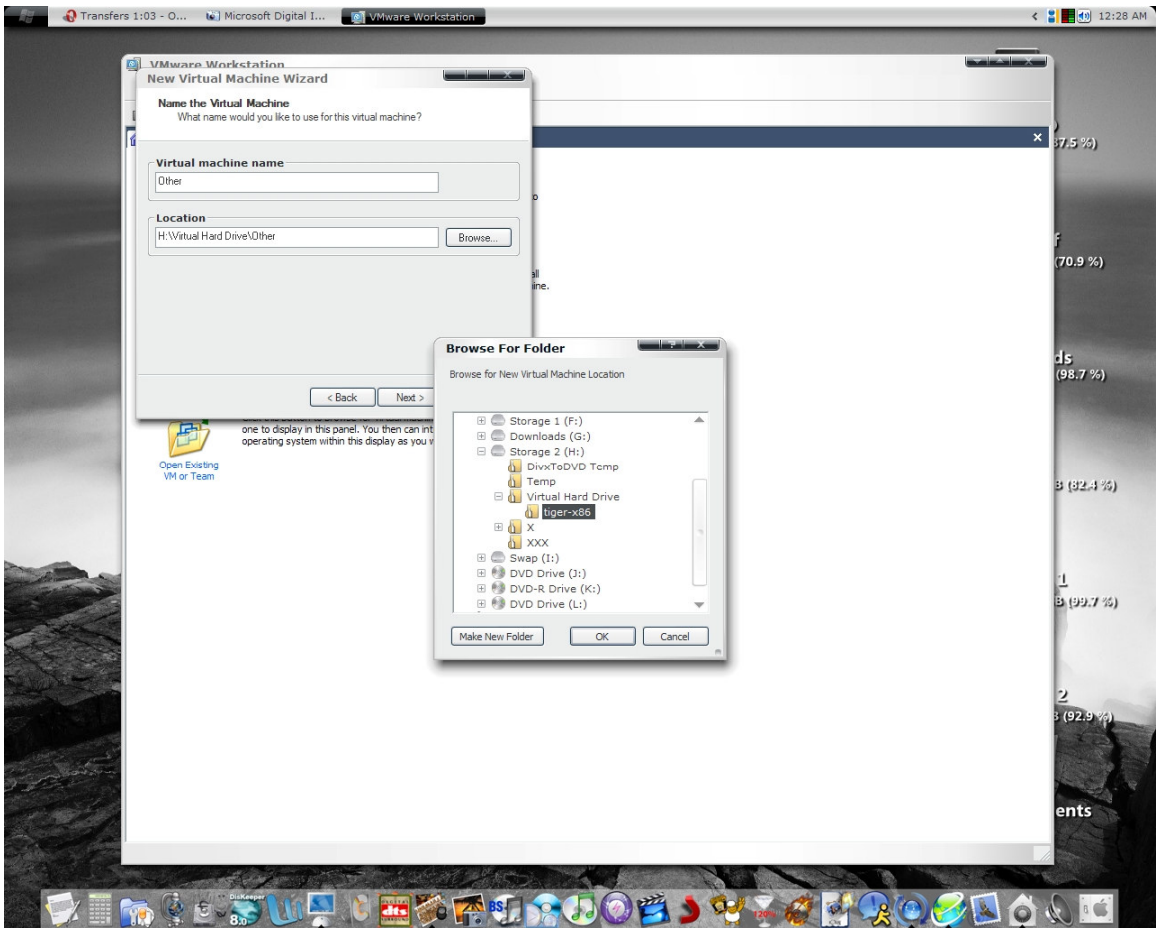
## Follow these steps to setup VMware to work with Tiger-x86.





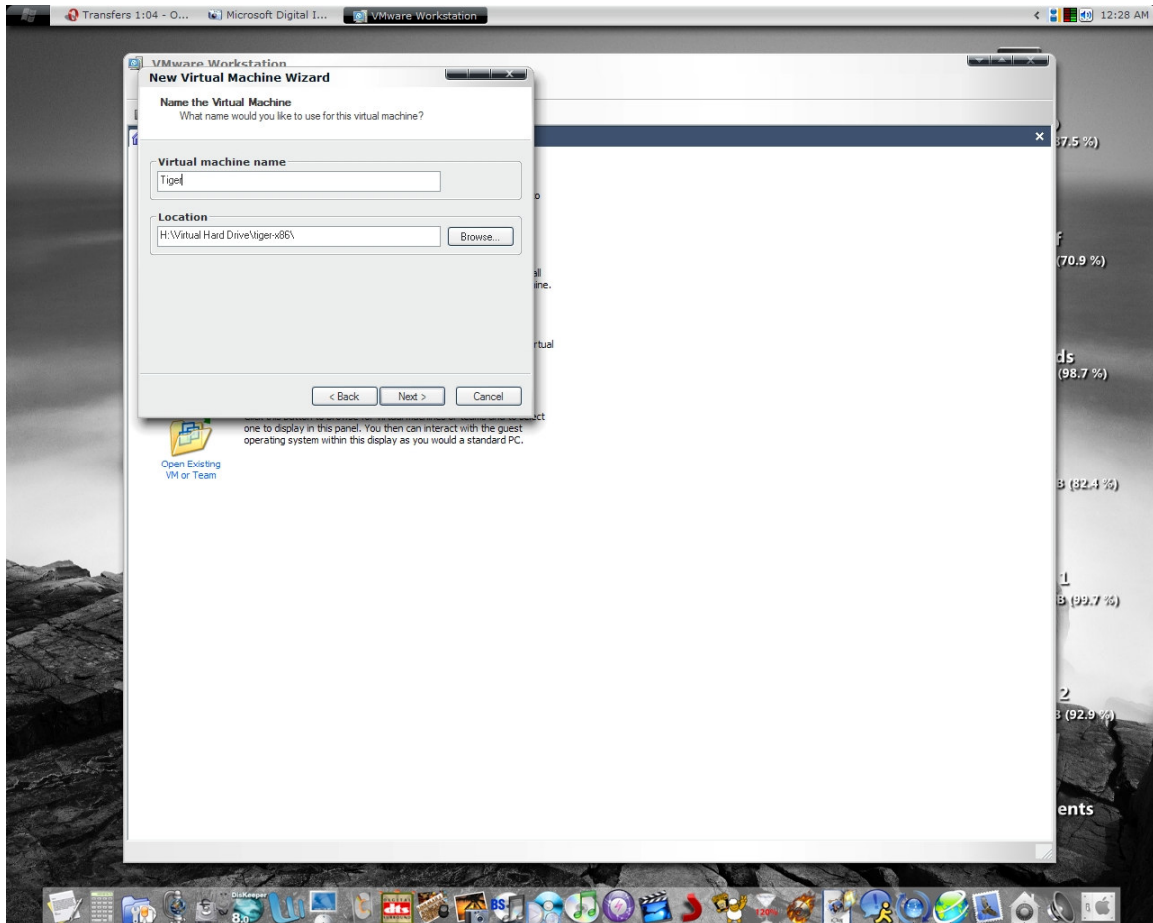




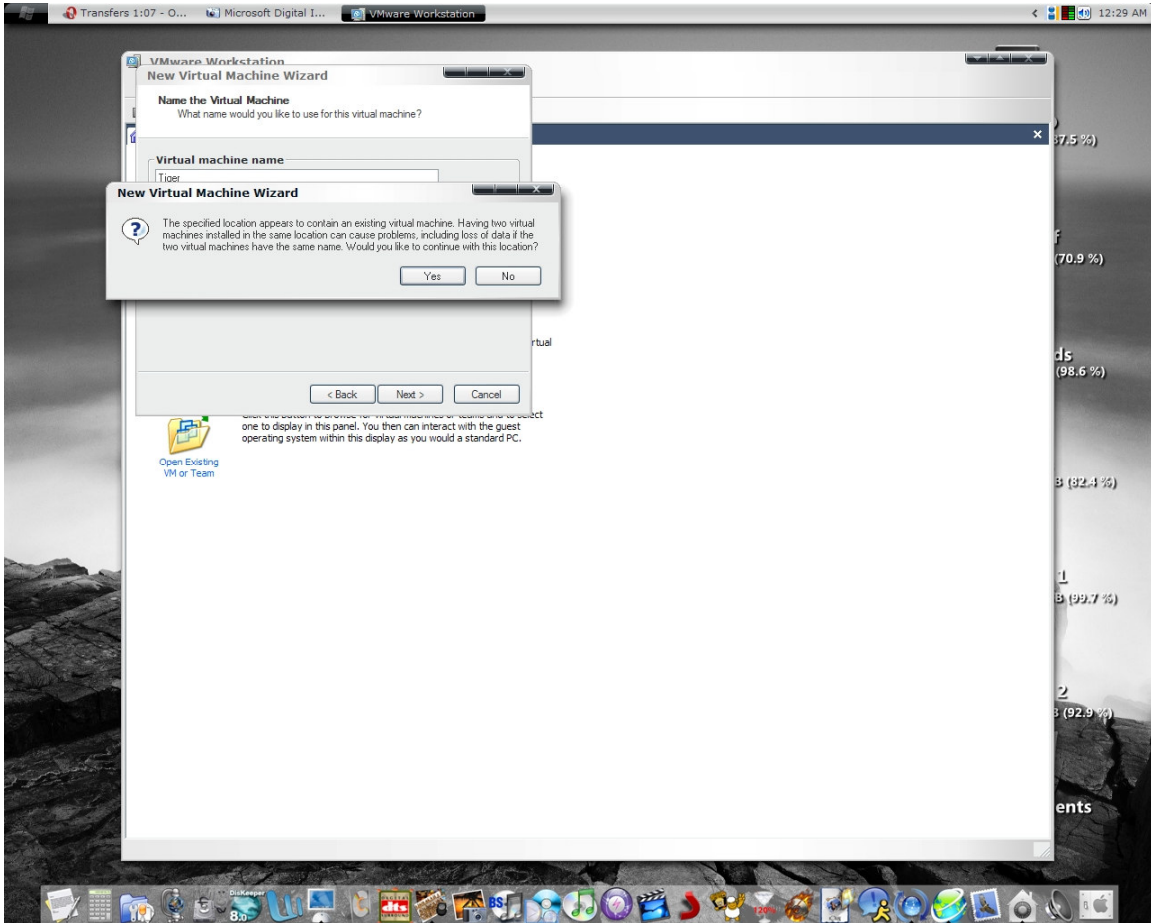


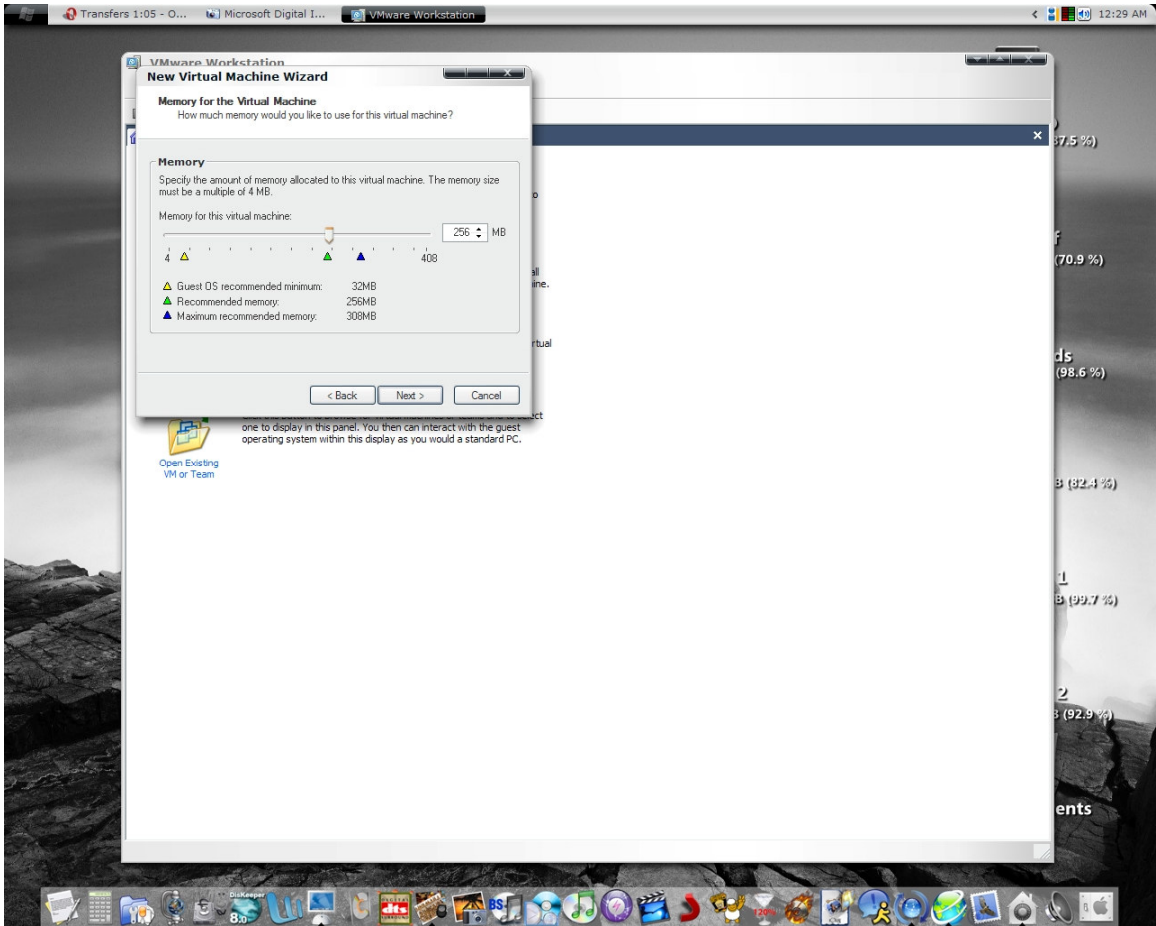


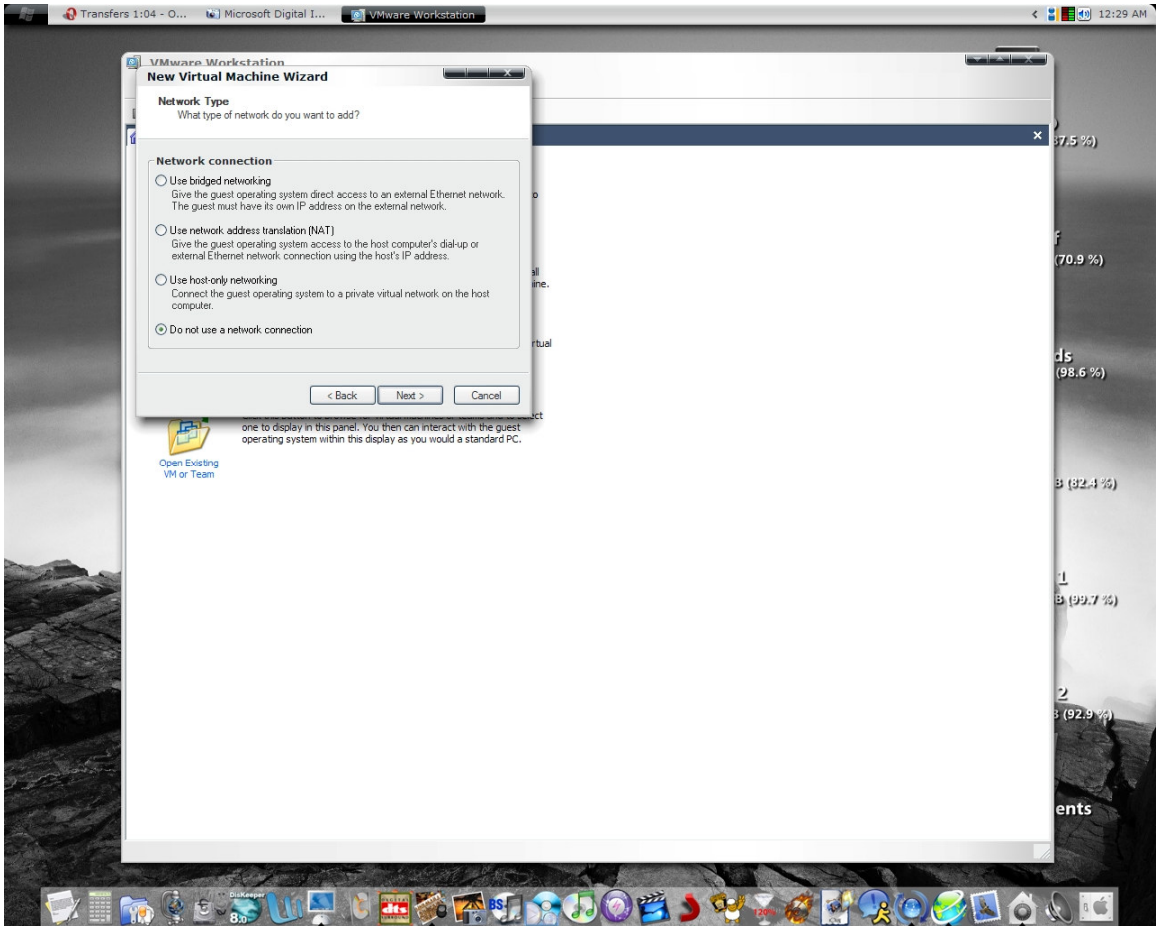
## Give your virtual machine a name: Tiger

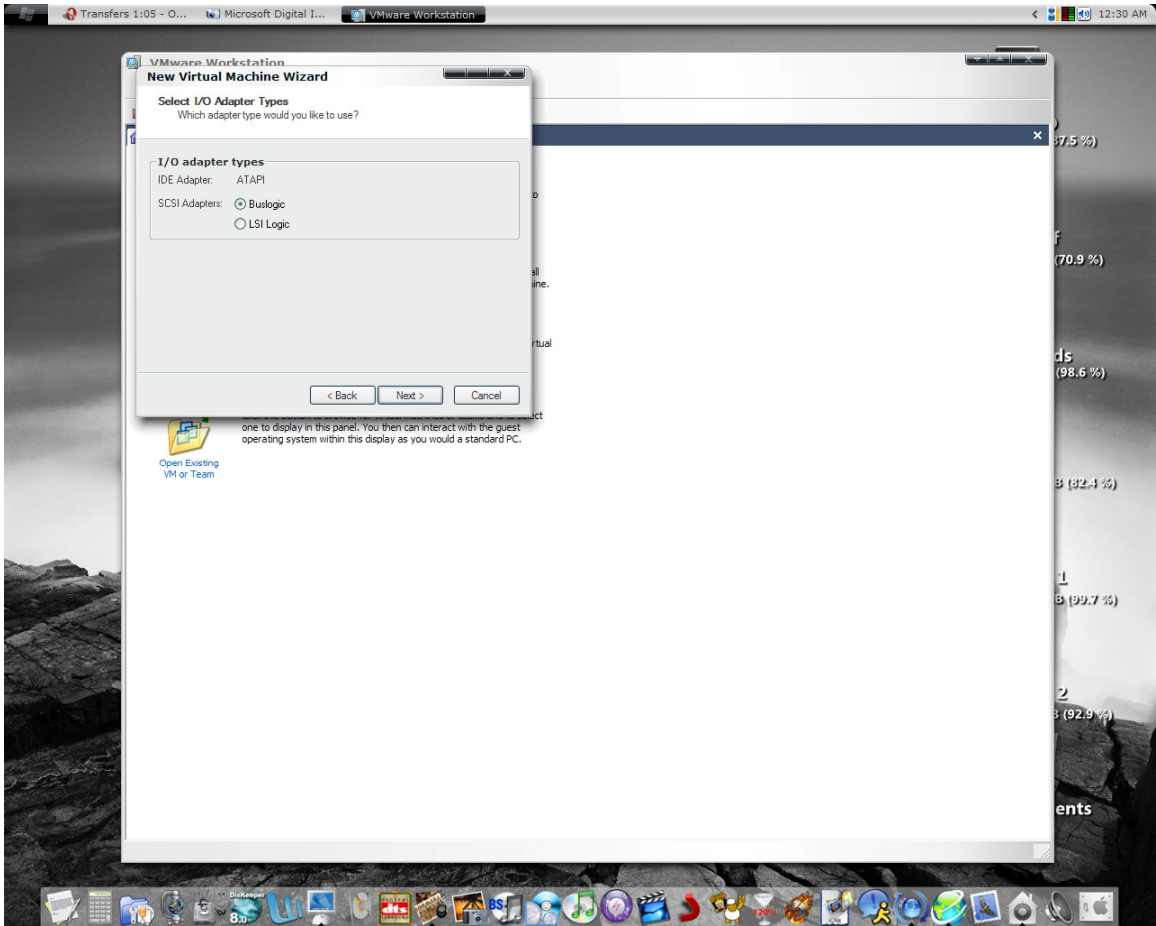


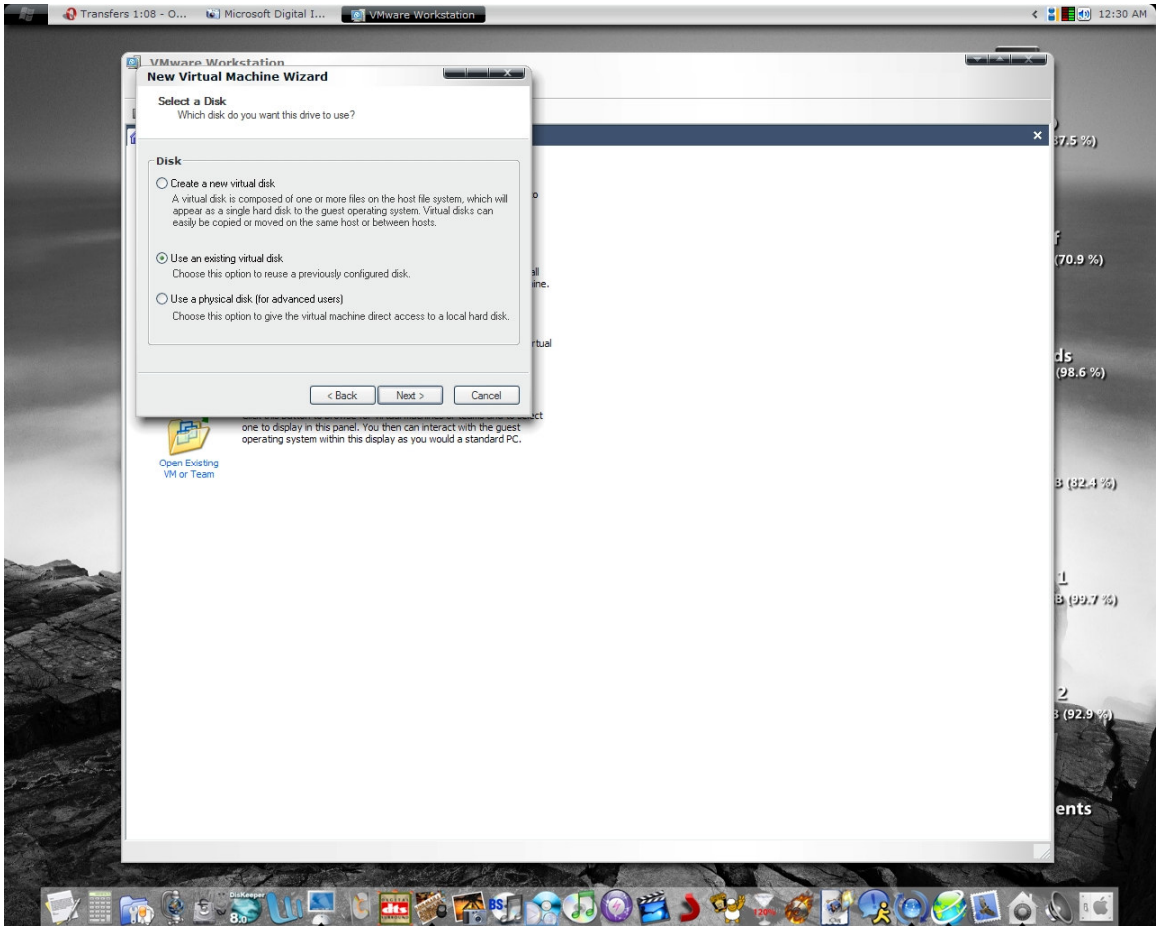

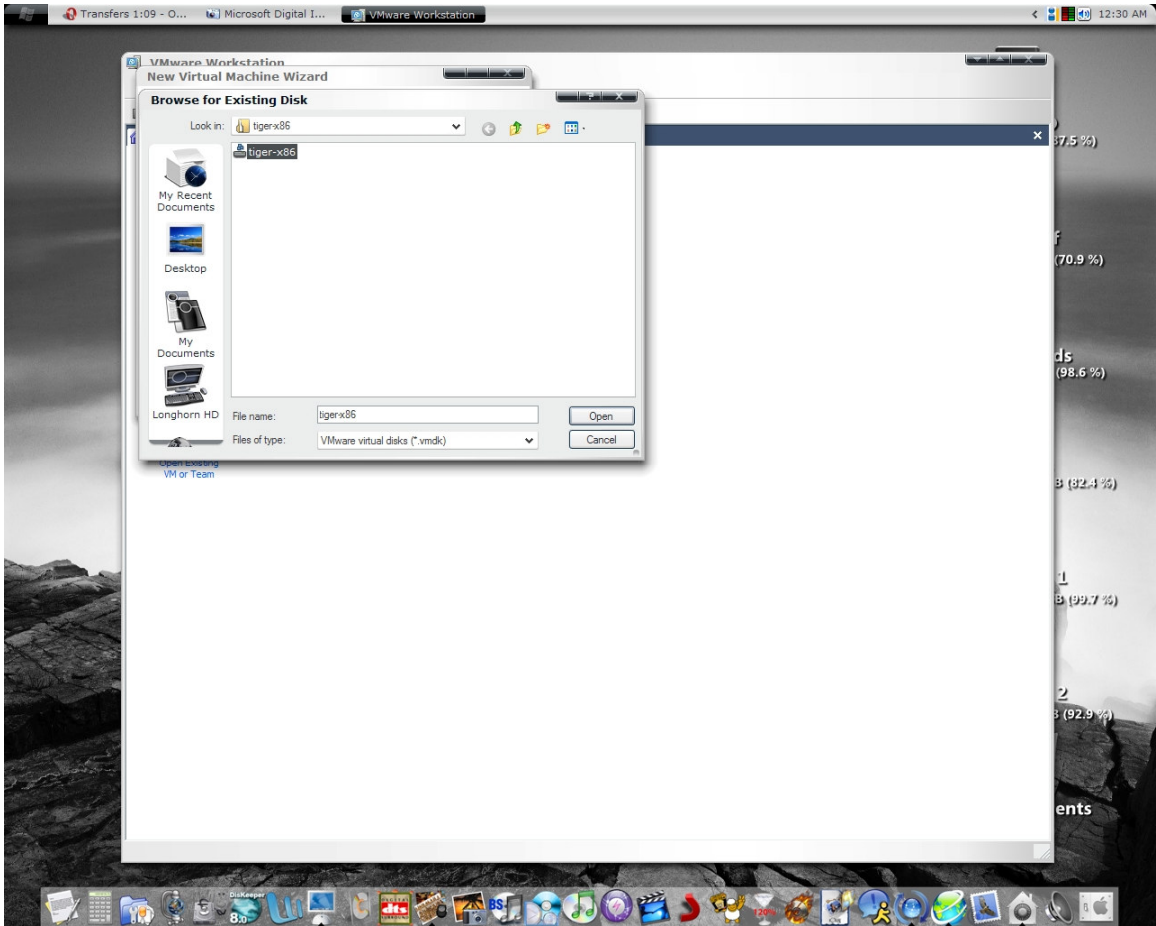


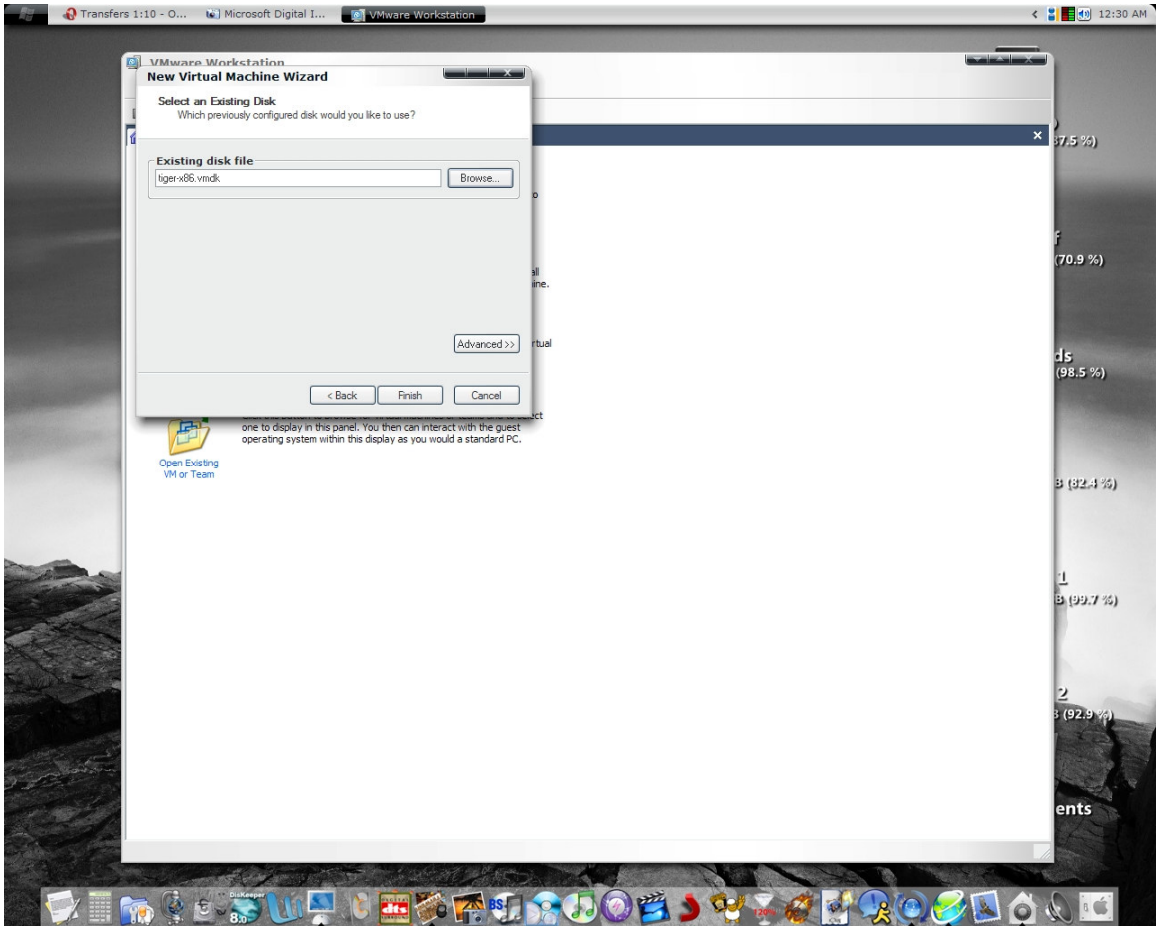




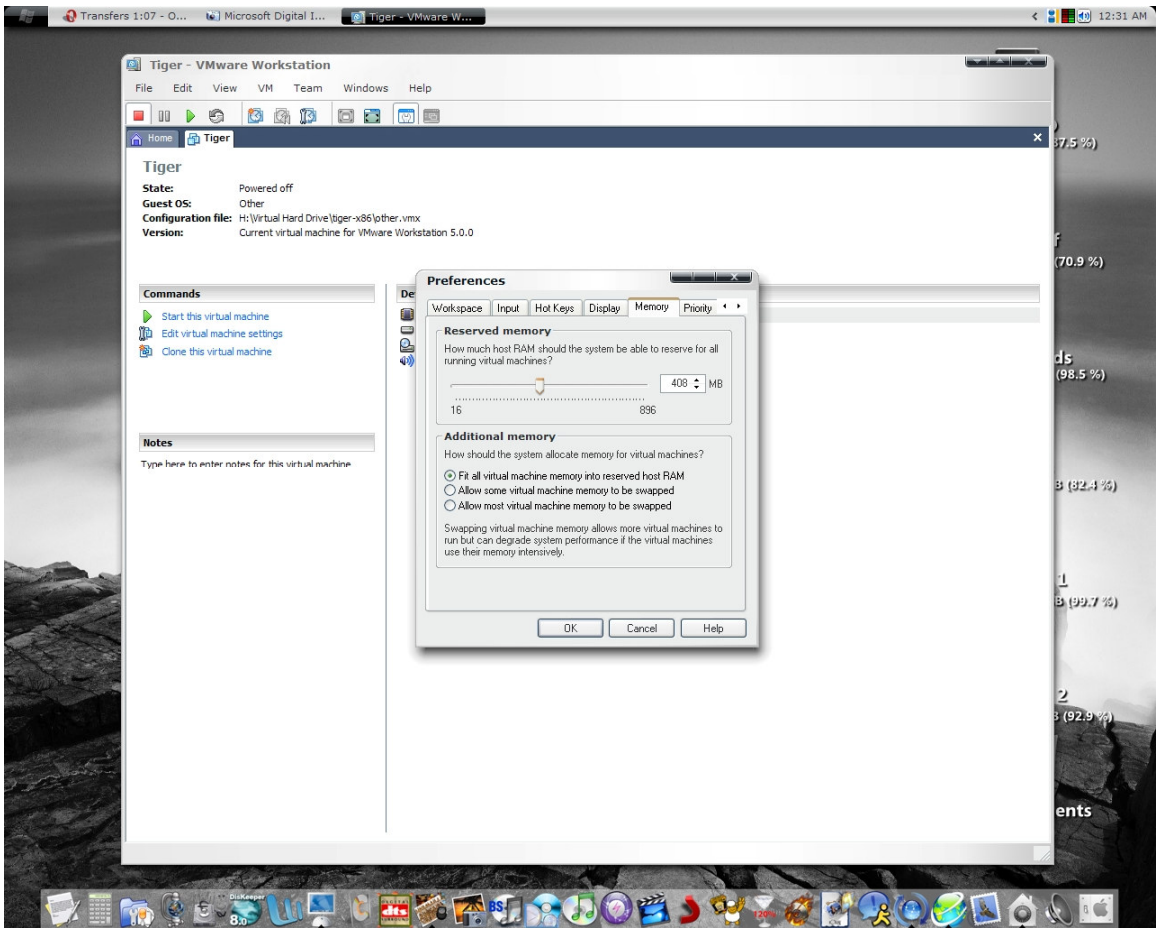


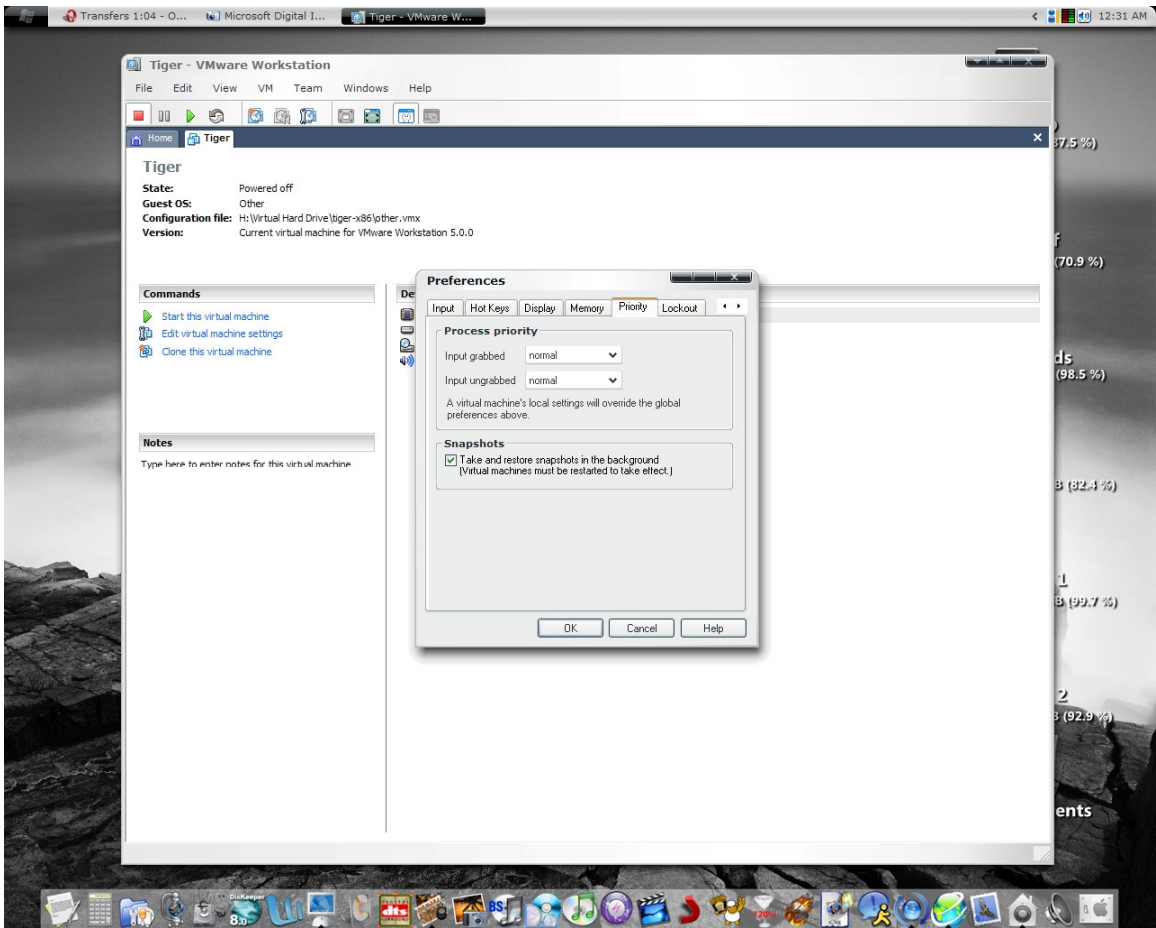




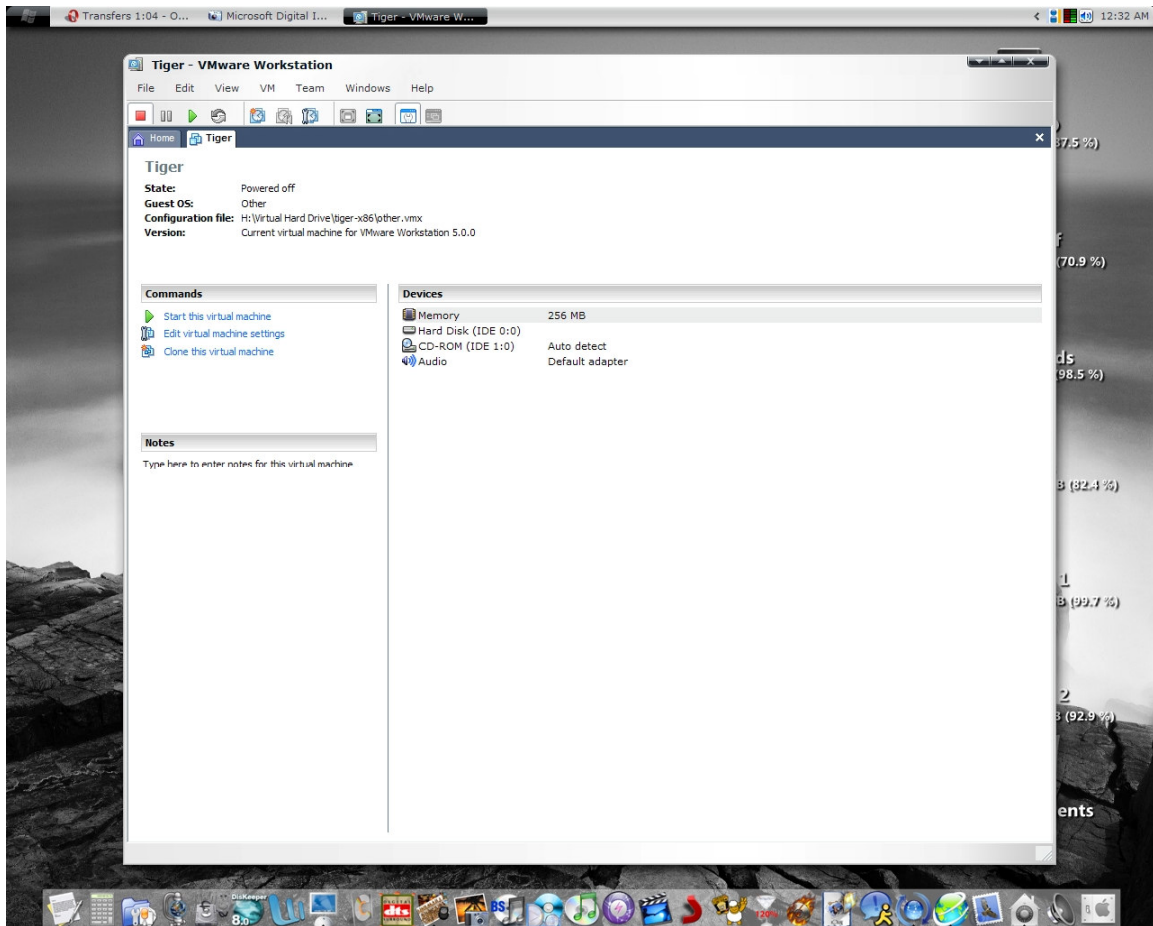


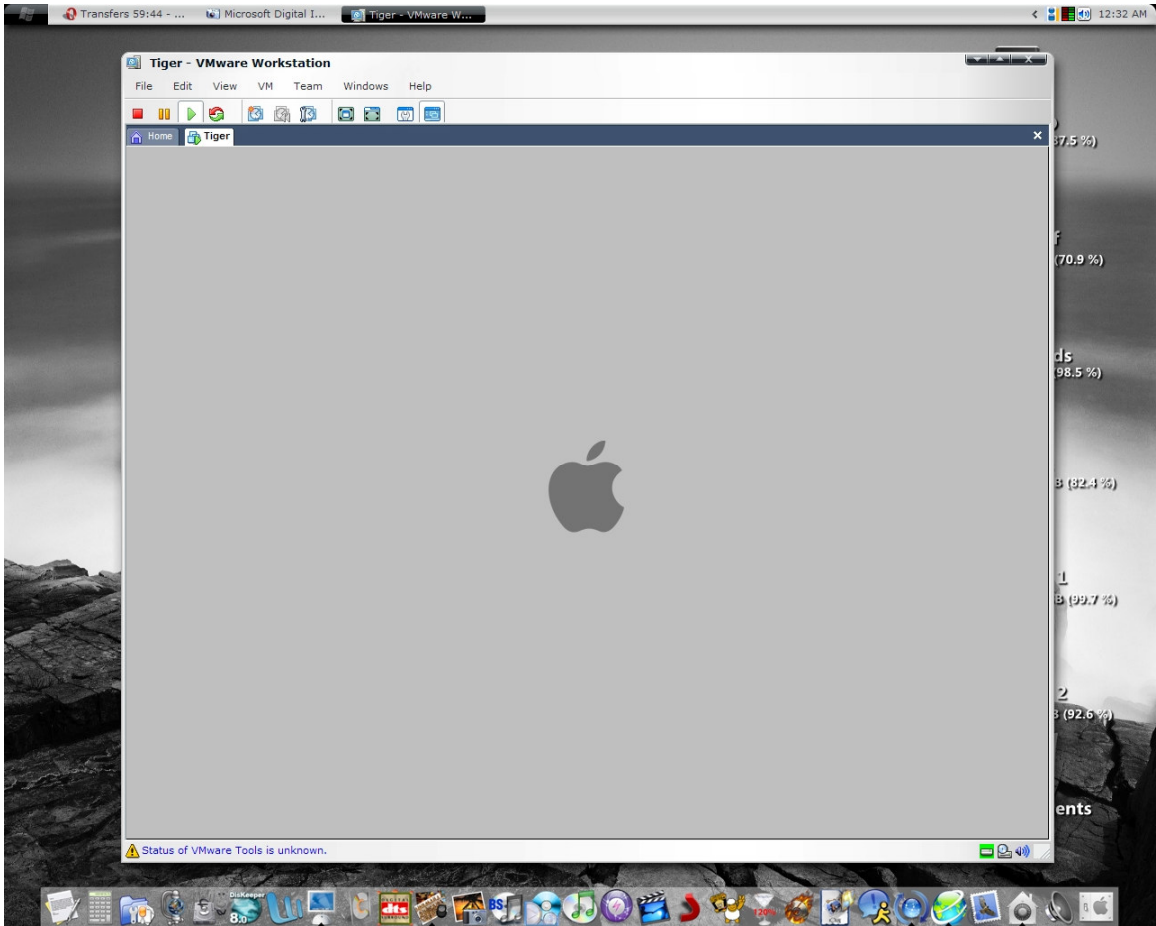






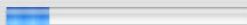
We are now ready to launch Tiger. Press the Green Arrow button on the top left corner of the VMware window to start Tiger.
