Read Before Installing or Using X.25 V1.1 for OpenVMS Alpha Systems AV-QTTFA-TE

This cover letter provides information on the product X.25 for OpenVMS Alpha Systems, V1.1. You should read this letter before attempting to install the product. Throughout the rest of this document, X.25 for OpenVMS Alpha Systems, V1.1 is referred to as X.25.

Layered Products Media

The OpenVMS Alpha Layered Products media, which contain X.25, comprise two types of Compact Disc:

- OpenVMS Alpha Software Product Library CD–ROM, which contains the installable subsets, Installation Guide and Release Notes (in ASCII and PostScript® form) for each layered product.
- OpenVMS Alpha Online Documentation Library CD–ROM, which contains user documentation in Bookreader® form for each layered product.

Bill of Materials (BOM)

Please read the BOM enclosed in this kit and verify that all items listed are actually in your kit. If your kit is damaged or any items are missing, call your Digital representative.

For information about installing X.25 on your system, refer to the *X.25 for OpenVMS Alpha Systems—Installation Guide*.

The Online Documentation Library CD-ROM contains X.25 documents in Bookreader format.

The following manuals are provided:

CD Booklet and CD Read First Letter

The *OpenVMS Alpha Layered Products Compact Disc User's Guide* booklet (CD booklet) and a *Read First* letter accompanies the CD distribution kit. The CD booklet:

- describes the directory names on the Software Product Library CD where product subsets are located:
- lists the documentation files on the Online Documentation Library CD provided for each product; and
- contains information on using Bookreader to read the Bookreader-formatted files from the Documentation CD device.

Installation Information

Installing X.25 requires the OpenVMS Alpha Operating System Version 6.2.

License Management Facility (LMF) Information

A License Management Facility (LMF) Product Authorisation Key (PAK) allows you to access a software product, and its documentation in Bookreader format. A PAK must be registered and loaded before you can install X.25 from the Digital CD–ROM Software Library for OpenVMS Alpha Layered Products. Refer to the CD *Read First* letter for information on LMF requirements needed to read the X.25 documentation using Bookreader.

Accessing Bookreader Documentation

To enable access to the X.25 Bookreader files, your system manager needs to define the DECW\$BOOK environment variable as described in the *OpenVMS Alpha Layered Products Compact Disc User's Guide* in the CD distribution kit. To read the X.25 documents, run Bookreader on a graphics terminal:

- **a.** Invoke Bookreader (refer to the *OpenVMS Alpha Layered Products Compact Disc User's Guide*); the initial or navigation Bookreader window is displayed.
- b. Within the navigation window, select the topic "Telecommunications and Networking".
- **c.** Select the topic "X.25 for OpenVMS Alpha Systems".
- **d.** Select the appropriate X.25 document. The table of contents for that document will be displayed.
